## **Attachment for Order Picker**

Order Picker Attachment - Order picking is likewise called order preparation operation. This is one of the key processes in a warehouse and consists of people called order pickers, collecting and taking articles in a specific quantity previous to shipment to be able to fulfill customer orders. Order picking is a basic warehousing process. The efficiency in which this particular task is completed can be directly related to a supply chain's productivity. Therefore, order picking is among the most controlled logistic processes. Order picking falls within the category of the warehouse management system.

There are certain kinds of order picking which comprise: wave picking method, pick to box method, picker to part method or piece picking, sorting systems method and zone picking method.

The pick to box method comprises the order picker just filling the boxes with item which are from their particular station. The box then moves on to other locations to until the order is finish. In this particular process, there is no movement of the order picker employees. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move round so as to gather the needed products for several orders. The piece picking or picker to part method is similar where the order pickers or picker move to gather the items needed but for one order only.

There is no movement by the order picker in the sorting systems method. Rather, things are brought to the order picker by an automatic system like for example an automatic storage system or a conveyor system. In the zone picking method, every order picker is assigned to one particular area. They are responsible for just realizing order picking in this specific zone.
