As soon as this step has been completed, all of the components are checked to see if they have any breakage, any extensive wear or any defects. Certain parts such as cylinder blocks, connecting blocks, cylinder heads and crankshafts are resized, reground and resurfaced if needed. Other components like for instance bolts, gears, nuts et cetera. are replaced or repaired as considered necessary.

As soon as the overhaul has been done, the engine is rebuilt manually. After being put back together, a series of tests are applied to the working machine in order to check all of the components and be positive there are no leaks or issues. If any problems occur, the needed modifications are made.
